## ANNEX I Logic and comprehension tests

In stage 2 of the competition, candidates will perform a test consisting of two tasks

- 1. Reading a text and answering multiple-choice questions in a maximum of 10 minutes;
- 2. Answering 22 questions in sequence, within a maximum of 10 minutes.

The test will last a maximum of 20-30 minutes.

The two tasks that make up the test will be completed at the same time, online. Candidates will be informed in advance of the exact date, time and location of the test. For reasons of copyright protection, screen shots of the test content are not permitted.

The organisers will analyse the results obtained in the two tasks:

1. Task (1) will have a weighting of 25%; task (2) will have a weighting of 75%;

2. The results will be identified according to the age groups [13-15] and [16-18].

At the end of stage 2, a maximum of 125 students will be retained for the rest of the selection process.
