Declare, for all practical purposes, that I authorize his/her participation in the "Astronaut for a day - Luxembourg" competition, promoted by the Luxembourg Space Agency, and, in the event that he/she is selected, that I authorize him/her to participate in the parabolic flight campaign between 28 September 2023, on board the Airbus A310 zero-G operated by Novespace, according to the terms of the information and conditions mentioned below, which I accept:

Aeronautical risks

The Passenger's Legal Representative is notified that the flights are classified as defined in Chapter 1 of the French Decree of 24 July 1991 relating to the conditions of use of civil aircraft in general aviation. It does not represent a public air transport activity within the meaning of the French Civil Aviation Code.

The aircraft holds a temporary flight licence issued by the Directorate General of Civil Aviation (DGAC), which is different from the Standard Certificate of Airworthiness (CofA) issued for public transport aircraft. The Passenger's Legal Representative accepts that the flight meets the specific requirements of the "General Aviation" regulations, and does not meet the safety standards defined for public air transport. As a result, the passenger's legal representative notes that the A310 zero-G qualification process has not been as thorough as certification for public transport aircraft, and that there are additional risks related to activities in the experimentation area, increased by the difficulty

of controlling movements under the effect of microgravity, and due to the absence of an automatic oxygen system in the experimentation area.

Participation in such a flight may lead to the cancellation of loan guarantees or insurance taken out for personal or professional purposes (property, death insurance, disability, etc.).

The Passenger's Legal Representative takes note of the recommendation made to him/her to verify that his/her insurance policies do not contain clauses rendering them null and void in the event of participation in a flight on board an aircraft without a standard certificate of airworthiness. The passenger's legal representative understands that, in this case, he/she will not benefit from these insurance policies.

The passenger's legal representative and the passenger agree that the passenger will comply with the flight regulations and obey the orders of the crew at all times.

Administration of medicines

The Passenger's Legal Representative authorizes the organizers to administer anti-emetic drugs prior to the parabolic flight.

Image rights

The passenger's legal representative authorizes the Luxembourg Space Agency and Novespace to photograph and/or film the passenger on the event site and inside the aircraft, and to use the passenger's image for promotional and communication purposes. The Passenger's Legal Representative is not authorized to sell or use the photographs or films taken on the campaign site or on board the aircraft for commercial or advertising purposes.

Covid-19 measures

If necessary, the Passenger or their Legal Representative may be required to provide Novespace with the result of either a negative PCR test, a sample of which must have been taken within 48 hours of arrival at the site, or a negative antigen test, a sample of which must have been taken within 24 hours of arrival at the site.

The passenger should be aware that the test is an additional mitigation measure and that it does not in any way eliminate the need for protective measures, physical distancing and the wearing of a mask, either on the campaign site or at his/her place of accommodation.

The passenger undertakes to comply with the widely disseminated Covid-19 recommendations, including physical distancing and protective measures, as well as specific Novespace recommendations that may be made during the campaign. In particular, the use of a surgical mask provided by Novespace is required inside and on board the aircraft. As a result, all drinks and meals should be taken outdoors.

The passenger's legal representative undertakes to check the passenger's temperature every day before arrival on site, and to consult a doctor and then a representative of Novespace, if he/she

presents Covid-19 symptoms or if, to his/her knowledge, he/she was a "contact at risk" of a person that tested positive for Covid-19.

The passenger's legal representative agrees to sign a declaration before each flight stating that the passenger does not have any symptoms of Covid-19 and that, to his/her knowledge, he/she has not been a "contact person at risk" of a person who has tested positive for Covid-19. Passengers having symptoms of Covid-19, or "being a person at risk" will be treated by Novespace medical staff on a case-by-case basis.

Passengers who test positive Covid within 15 days of their scheduled arrival date will not be allowed to board Novespace during the flight campaign. People having a "contact at risk" should follow the rules of the health authorities on the date of the contact.

The preventive measures related to Covid-19 will be evaluated near the date of flight, in collaboration with Novespace and the relevant health authorities.

Personal data

The personal data collected by the Agence spatiale Luxembourgeoise – Luxembourg Space Agency Foundation, to register for the Astronaut for a day - Luxembourg initiative will be used exclusively for sending information about this event and related initiatives and will be shared with the partners concerned by the initiative, whether institutions or individuals. If you wish to limit the processing of your data to a telephone or email contact, or delete any of the above, you can do so by sending an email to info@astronautforaday.lu. The consent given for the processing of personal data may be revoked at any time by the interested party. To this end, or to exercise their rights of access, rectification, opposition, erasure, limitation and portability, the interested parties must express their wish by sending a written request to the e-mail address of info@astronautforaday.lu.

The Passenger's Legal Representative agrees that Novespace may collect the Passenger's personal data and documents, share them with the airport authorities and the Medical University of Caen, in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (EU 2016/679), with the aim of organising parabolic flight campaigns. The passenger's legal representative understands that the information may be retained for a minimum of 15 years if necessary (as required by French law for medical information, if applicable). The passenger's legal representative understands that he/she can request information about his/her personal data stored at Novespace, or request rectification of the data if it proves to be incorrect, or that it be deleted, upon simple request to contact2@novespace.fr.

The Passenger's Legal Representative agrees that medical data relating to Covid-19 measures will remain confidential within Novespace's medical staff, that it will be kept for one month after the campaign and that it will then be deleted.

Practice of a sports activity

As part of the "Astronaut for a day - Luxembourg" competition, candidates will take part in sports activities. The Passenger's Legal representative is aware of the risk of injury during physical activity and accepts this risk.
